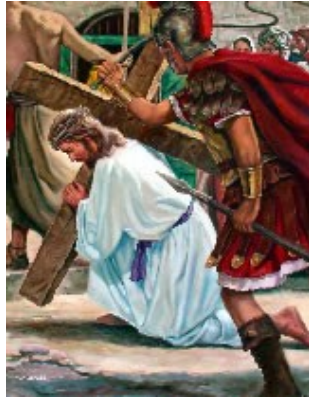


# Christ in All the Bible

## Lesson Five

### 1. Of whom does Christ Himself tell us that the Scriptures speak about?

“Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_.” John 5:39.

Note: “Search the Old Testament Scriptures: for they are they that testify of Christ. To find Him in them is the true and legitimate end of their study. To be able to interpret them as He interpreted them is the best result of all Bible learning.” Dean Alford.

### 2. About whom did Moses and the Old Testament prophets write?

“Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, we have found him of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, \_\_\_\_\_, the son of Joseph.” John 1:45.

Note: In her translation of the Old Testament Scriptures, Helen Spurrell expressed the following wish for all who should read her translation: “May very many exclaim, as the translator has often done when studying numerous passages in the original, *I have found the Messiah!*”

### 3. Who revealed beforehand the death and resurrection of Christ?

“O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that \_\_\_\_\_ have spoken: ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into His glory?” Luke 24:25, 26.

### 4. Does all of Scripture tell us about Jesus?

“And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_.” Luke 24:27.

### 5. Where in the Bible is the first promise of the Redeemer?

“And the Lord God said unto the serpent, I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and \_\_\_\_\_; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” Genesis 3:14,15.

**6. In what words was this great truth explained to Abraham?**

“\_\_\_\_\_ shall all the nations of the earth be blessed.” Genesis 22:18. (See also Genesis 26:4; 28:14.)

**7. To whom did this promised seed refer?**

“Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, \_\_\_\_\_.” Galatians 3:16.

**8. Whom did God promise would especially guide Israel to the Promised Land?**

“Behold, I send \_\_\_\_\_ before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.” Exodus 23:20.

**9. Who was the Rock that went with them?**

“And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed (literally, “went with”) them: and \_\_\_\_\_.” 1 Corinthians 10:4.

**10. Where was the promised Saviour to be born?**

“But thou, \_\_\_\_\_ Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, unto Me that is to be Ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.” Micah 5:2.

**11. In what Old Testament prophecy are the life, suffering, and death of Christ foretold?**

The life, suffering, and death of Christ is found in the fifty-third chapter of Isaiah.

**12. Which passage of Scripture foretold the price of Christ’s betrayal?**

“So they weighed for My price \_\_\_\_\_.” Zechariah 11:12. (See Matthew 26:15.)

**13. Christ’s dying words were written a thousand years before His death. Where are they found?**

“My God, My God why has Thou forsaken Me?” Psalm 22:1. (See Matthew 27:46.) “Into Thy hands I commit My spirit.” Psalm 31:5. (See Luke 23:46.)

**14. In what passage do the Psalms also foretell Christ’s resurrection?**

“For \_\_\_\_\_; neither wilt Thou suffer Thine Holy One to see \_\_\_\_\_.” Psalm 16:10. (See Acts 2:25-31.)

**15. What words does Daniel use to describe Christ’s receiving of His kingdom?**

“I saw in the night visions, and behold, One like \_\_\_\_\_ came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought Him near before Him. And \_\_\_\_\_, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve Him: His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.” Daniel 7:13, 14. (See also Luke 1:32, 33; 19:11, 12; Revelation 11:15.)

**16. How does the book of Psalms describe Christ's Second Advent?**

“Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be joyful together before the Lord; \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ : with righteousness shall He judge the world, and  
the people with equity.” Psalm 98:8, 9.

“ \_\_\_\_\_ : a fire shall devour before Him,  
and it shall be very tempestuous round about Him. He shall call to the heavens from above, and  
to the earth, that He may judge His people.” Psalm 50:3, 4.
