# The Divinity of Christ

## Lesson Eleven

### 1. Is Christ set forth as a divine being in Holy Writ?

"But unto the Son He saith, Thy throne O \_\_\_\_\_, is forever and ever . . . \_\_\_\_\_, even Thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above Thy fellows." Hebrews 1:8, 9.

### 2. Did Christ exist before He was manifested in the flesh?

"And now, O Father, glorify Thou Me with Thine own self with the glory which I had with Thee \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ was." John 17:5.

### 3. By what agency was His incarnation effected?

"And the angel answered and said unto her, \_\_\_\_\_ shall come upon thee, and the power of the \_\_\_\_\_ shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God." Luke 1:35.

### 4. Did His incarnation annul His divinity?

"\_\_\_\_\_ was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory." 1 Timothy 3:16.

### 5. How does Christ Himself speak of His relation to the Father?

"I and My Father are \_\_\_\_\_." John 10:30.

### 6. How does He show what He means by being "one with the Father?"

"And now I am no more in the world, but \_\_\_\_\_ are in the world, and I come to Thee. Holy Father, keep through Thine own name those whom Thou hast given Me, that they may be \_\_\_\_\_, as We are." John 17:11.

Note: One in purpose, spirit, work, etc.; and the same is true of those who have truly learned of Christ.

**7. How was He manifested on the earth as a Saviour?**

"For unto you is \_\_\_\_\_ this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11.

"And the Word was made \_\_\_\_\_, and dwelt among us (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father), full of grace and truth." John 1:14.

**8. Why was He thus made known?**

"Wherefore in all things it behooved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful \_\_\_\_\_ in things pertaining to God, to make \_\_\_\_\_ for the sins of the people." Hebrews 2:17.

**9. How was He recognized by the Father while here?**

"And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved \_\_\_\_\_, in whom I am well pleased." Matthew 3:17.

**10. How was the divinity of the Son of God shown?**

1. In His creative power. Colossians 1:13-16; John 1:1-3.
2. By His power to perform miracles. John 11:43, 44.
3. By His being recognized as God. Hebrews 1:7, 8; Isaiah 9:6.
4. By what He endured for a race of rebels. Isaiah 53:10-12.

**11. How does Paul speak of Christ's relation to the Father?**

"In Him dwelleth all the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Godhead bodily." Colossians 2:9.

**12. What is our privilege in view of what this precious Saviour has done?**

"For we have not a High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore \_\_\_\_\_ boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may \_\_\_\_\_ mercy, and \_\_\_\_\_ grace to help in time of need." Hebrews 4:15, 16.
