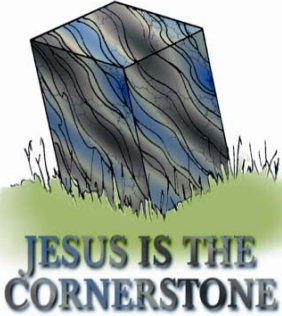


Hope
